Bio: A former Core Faculty at Sofia University, Palo Alto, California, Kundan Singh, PhD is currently a Core Doctoral Faculty at the Hindu University of America where he is engaged in developing a completely new field in academia, Postcolonial Hindu Studies, and a department that will specialize in Yoga Psychology. He is the Vice President of the Cultural Integration Fellowship—an institution inspired by the teachings of the Integral Yoga of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother in San Francisco—and a Senior Fellow at Hindupedia, Cupertino, California. He serves as an adjunct faculty at the California Institute of Integral Studies in San Francisco and has been a visiting faculty at the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley and the director of Center for Integral Studies at Auro University in India. He is the author of “The Evolution of Integral Yoga: Sri Aurobindo, Sri Ramakrishna, and Swami Vivekananda” (VDM Verlag) and numerous book chapters in edited books, such as Beyond Mind: The Future of Psychology as Science,” “Beyond Postmodernism: Towards a Future Psychology,” “Relativism, Self-Referentiality, and Beyond Mind,” “Relativism and its Relevance for Psychology,” and “Sri Aurobindo’s Invalidation of the Aryan Invasion Theory and the Contemporary Western Archeological Evidence.” He has lectured extensively in San Francisco Bay Area and has many academic presentations at international and national conferences to his name.
