We would like to remind you of the biannual Science Award in honour of Dr. Lotte Köhler.

The "Hans Kilian and Lotte Köhler Centre (KKC) for Social and Cultural Psychology and Historical Anthropology" and the "Sigmund Freud Institute (SFI)" are announcing the prize for the second time.

The first awardees were Sudhir Kakar from Goa University (India) and Jacob Johanssen from St. Mary's College, London (United Kingdom).

The prize will be awarded in two categories (main category and Young Researcher Award).

Eligible nominees in the main category must have significantly contributed to the profile and dissemination of psychoanalytical, developmental, cultural or social psychological identity research.

The Young Researcher Award will be awarded on the basis of an individual piece of work in the form of an outstanding doctoral dissertation or master's thesis.

Nominations must be submitted to both institutions, the KKC and the SFI, by September 15, 2023.
